

Dear Patients

If you have been to a hotspot area and you have been asked to isolate or if you are a close contact of someone with COVID then please do not attend our clinic and instead you can access a telehealth/Video consultation with your doctor. Call reception 07 3261 7000

If you are unwell with any fever, respiratory, ear nose throat, or abdominal illness then you are not to enter our Clinic. Call our reception team who will provide you with advice on how you can be seen. Help us to protect our staff and vulnerable patients.

Mask are mandatory to enter our clinic due to the closeness of potentially unwell people to other patients and our staff.

Although we respect the rights of those patients who choose to remain unvaccinated, we ask that you respect our rights to ask you not to enter our clinic unless a doctor has triaged your visit. We will be asking for proof of vaccination at check in.

Covid 19 vaccination clinics have restarted for those people that have already received 2 vaccine doses and are 18 years and over who are due for a booster 4 months after there second dose. Limited Pfizer vaccines are available. Please call our reception team to make a booking 07 3261 7000.

Children that are registered with our clinic aged between 5-11 years can access a Pfizer vaccine. Stock is limited. Please call our reception team to make a booking 07 3261 7000.

Metro North Hospital and Health Service is conducting COVID-19 screening at fever clinics in a range of locations and the Pine Rivers Community Assessment Clinic. These clinics are for anyone in Queensland:

- with fever ($\geq 37.5^{\circ}\text{C}$) or history of fever (e.g., night sweats, chills) OR
- acute respiratory infection (e.g., cough, shortness of breath, sore throat) OR
- a loss of smell or loss of taste OR
- anyone presenting for, or requesting, testing.

Other reported symptoms of COVID-19 include: fatigue, runny nose, muscle pain, joint pain, diarrhoea, nausea/vomiting and loss of appetite.
